Writing Format

Sentence 1	What was the topic of your reading?
Sentence 2	What did you know about the topic before you read?
Sentence 3	Why did you pick this article?
Sentences 4 and 5	What new information did you learn while reading the article? Did anything surprise you, challenge what you already knew? Stumped on understanding?
Sentences 6, 7, and 8	Compare your thoughts about the topic before reading to your thoughts about the topic after you read.
Sentences 9 and 10	Make at least one connection to the article: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Text-to-text- Text-to-self- Text-to-world
Sentence 11	Concluding sentence that sums up what you learned from your reading.
